

Ms. Smith - Grade 7 Spanish Summer Assignment - Todo sobre mi (All about me)



Overview: ¡Hola mis estudiantes futuros! Hello my future students! For your summer assignment you will create a mini presentation (in Spanish!) to introduce yourself to our class.

Directions: Use the words and phrases on the attached vocab sheets to put together basic sentences or pieces of information about yourself. Add photos and/or clip art to represent the words and phrases. This is NOT a paragraph, but rather a splattering of words and phrases about you.

Organization: Use an 8 ½ by 11 piece of white paper or construction paper. (This is the size of computer paper.) You can use any type of layout you want, for example, you can do a border with the Spanish words and phrases, or you can use photos and put words above or below them. You can also do your work on the computer and print it out. **BE CREATIVE!**

Requirements: You need to use **at least 15** Spanish words or phrases. For example, if you use the word “doce” that counts as 1, and if you use the phrase, “Me llamo Ana” that counts as 1. You also need photos, drawings, or clip art to represent the text. Here is the rubric for how you will earn your grade:
