## The Great CCLCS Sea Camps Overnight 2019

#### WHAT IS SEA CAMPS?

Sea Camps is our first all-school community event of the year -- a time for students, staff, and families to get to know each other. Students travel in mixed-grade groups throughout the day, participating in activities led by staff and parents. During the evening, we hold our annual talent show, followed by an overnight in the cabins. The following morning, the event concludes with breakfast and a slideshow. In order to participate at Sea Camps, all families must complete the attached forms and submit with payment no later than Tuesday, September 24th. If you are a family with more than one child at CCLCS, you may fill out just one form and submit two payments.

### **VOLUNTEERING AT SEA CAMPS**

If you are able to help out, please fill out the Volunteer Sign-up Sheet and return to the office by Tuesday, September 24th. Volunteers will receive a confirmation email by September 27th to confirm participation. If you cannot join us during the day, please plan to come for the talent show that evening.

### WHEN IS SEA CAMPS? THURSDAY, OCT. 3rd and FRIDAY, OCT. 4th

Students should be dropped off at the Cape Cod Sea Camps in Brewster on Thursday morning between 8:35 and 8:45. Students who regularly take the CCLCS bus will be picked up at the regular time and stop (or close to allowing extra time for loading gear onto the bus) and delivered to Sea Camps. No DART or Flex bus will be stopping at Sea Camps. We will be at Sea Camps all day Thursday, sleepover Thursday night, and spend Friday morning with pick-up at Sea Camps promptly at 11:30am. CCLCS yellow buses will pick students up at Sea Camps and deliver to bus stops.

## MEAL INFORMATION: <u>Sea Camps is a Nut Free Facility</u>

**Thursday lunch:** Students will be served lunch prepared by Sea Camps Staff. The cost is \$10.00 per student. Please contact the school with any dietary concerns and we will make sure the dining hall accommodates your child's needs

**Thursday dinner:** Students are served a spaghetti dinner prepared by Sea Camps staff. Cost is \$10.00 per student. Please contact the school with any dietary concerns and we will make sure the dining hall accommodates your child's needs. Dinner is for students and staff only.

*Friday Breakfast:* A full breakfast will be served to all students Friday morning, and is included as part of the fee paid to Sea Camps for the overnight. Again, please make a note if there is a dietary concern.

## TALENT SHOW: THURSDAY EVENING 6:30 promptly

Students will be asked to submit a brief description of their act, a list of the people performing in that act, any music, and lyrics for musical numbers. Practicing should be done at home. **Due to limited seating at the amphitheater, we must limit attendance to current CCLCS students and their immediate families**. Sorry, no friends or former students. Any Talent Show questions can be directed to Emily Nowack at school or email enowack@cclcs.info.

**OVERNIGHT:** Students will be spending the night at Sea Camps. Divided into cabins by gender and grade, and accompanied by staff and parent chaperones, the grade levels determine the appropriate time for "lights out" so students will sleep comfortably and quietly all night long. Only pillows are provided, so a sleeping bag or bedding must be brought. **There is a \$35 per student charge for the overnight** (which includes breakfast on Friday), but think of what a babysitter would have cost!

FRIDAY MORNING: The morning program will be a continuation of Thursday's events. Some time will be spent cleaning up the camp, and our stay at Sea Camps will come to a close with a massive, all-school game of capture the flag. Students need to be picked up at Sea Camps at 11:30am. Students who regularly take the CCLCS yellow buses will be picked up at Sea Camps and delivered to their usual stops at the usual early dismissal times. No DART or Flex bus will be stopping at the Sea Camps.

\*Please make every effort to be on time!\* It will have been a long and exciting time for both your child and our staff so everyone may be tired and eager to get home.

# The CCLCS Sea Camps Overnight NEED TO BRING LIST

Please put a name on anything that can be marked so we can return if it becomes separated from your child. A little masking tape and a Sharpie can save us all a lot of time!

\*Here is a brief list of suggested clothes and supplies for our trip to Sea Camps. We will be outside and on our feet most of the day, so comfortable shoes and layered clothing are a must. It can get chilly during the evening, and on Friday morning, so check the weather and plan accordingly. Possibilities to consider:

- Rain gear

- Plenty of snacks for Thursday (Sea Camps is a nut free facility)

## A NOTE FROM THE NURSE:

Before any prescription or over the counter medications can be administered, you must fill out the *Medication Permission Form*. This pertains to all medications, including inhalers that your child may carry. All medications needing to be administered must be delivered to school with written parental permission, and given to Mrs. Smith, the School Nurse *by September* 24, 2019. Children are not allowed by law to carry any medication, except authorized inhalers and EpiPens. Medications normally given during school hours will automatically be given at the regular times, unless other arrangements are made with Mrs. Smith. It would be very helpful for parents to administer evening medications if they attend dinner and the talent show.
