NEED EMERGENCY FORMS BACK! – Your child should have come home with the beginning of the year paperwork packet and brought it all back by now. <u>It is very important to update the Student Emergency Information Form and send it in.</u> If you have not returned this form yet, please do this week. Student with an Immune Deficiency Disorder at CCLCS - A child at CCLCS this year has an immune deficiency disorder as well as other health issues. Immunodeficiency disorders involve malfunction of the immune system, resulting in infections that develop and recur more frequently, are more severe, and last longer than usual. This immune disorder places the child at great risk of serious infection. Viruses that may seem fairly common place to most children, will actually become much greater infections in this child. For example, the common cold virus would turn into pneumonia and cause significant respiratory issues, causing possible hospitalization. This child is more susceptible to infections and his body cannot fight off illnesses effectively. Also this immune disorder made certain vaccinations impossible, so this child does not have the coverage of vaccines like most.

In order for this child to have a successful, healthy year it is important that all families follow the health care guidelines. Children with fevers or vomiting need to stay out of school until they are fever or vomit free for 24 hours. Please contact the nurse's office with all communicable illnesses. Reminders of proper hand washing will go a long way to protect everyone! Let's work together to make this a healthy, successful year. If there are any questions, please contact the Nurses office.
